

## Clarification on PG Second Selection Process

It is to clarify all the applicants of CPET-2021 that the Second Selection will be made on the following procedure.

**Scenario-1:** If the candidate got selected and took admission in one subject out of the selected subjects & opted for slide-up, then the candidate's options will be considered as per the below-mentioned.

- Except higher options of the selected subject, where candidate got selected and took admission, all lower options of that subject will be closed.
- Lower options of the other selected subjects, where candidate got selected, but didn't take admission will be closed. Only higher options will be considered.
- All options of the subjects, where the candidate didn't get selected at all, will be considered.

**Scenario-2:** If the candidate got selected and took admission in one subject out of multiple selected subjects & did not opt for slide-up, then the candidate's options will be considered as per the below-mentioned.

- Except the option, where candidate got selected and took admission, all higher & lower options of that subject will be closed.
- Lower options of the other selected subjects, where candidate got selected, but didn't take admission will be closed. Only higher options will be considered.
- All options of the subjects, where the candidate didn't get selected at all, will be considered.

**Scenario-3:** If the candidate got selected in all his opted subjects and didn't take admission in any one of the selected subject, then all selected and lower options of the selected subjects will be closed. Only higher options will be considered.

**Scenario-4:** If the candidate got selected in all his opted subject's higher options and didn't take admission in any one of the selected subject, then such candidates will not be considered.

NB - If the candidate got selected in multiple subjects in 1<sup>st</sup> selection and candidate took admission in one subject & opted for slide-up.

In the second selection candidate gets selected in any of the higher preference of the admitted subject then, following scenarios may arise

- a) It is mandatory for him/her to take admission in higher preference to participate in the subsequent selection process for that subject.
- b) If candidate doesn't take admission in the higher preference of the selected subject in second selection, then all the options of that subject (Higher, Selected, Lower and admitted) will be closed.
- c) In no case, a candidate will be allowed to remain in the lower preferences.
