

## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) for PG SPOT Admission 2021-22: -

**1. Who are eligible to apply for SPOT Admission?**

Ans.

- a) Candidates who were previously selected & taken admission and/ or previously selected & not taken admission in 1st & 2nd selection.
- b) Candidates who have appeared CPET-2021, but not selected in 1st & 2nd Selection.
- c) Candidate who have not uploaded graduation mark.
- d) Candidate who have appeared CPET-2021 but not exercised choice of preferences.

**2. How can I get my Common Application Form (CAF) for SPOT admission?**

Ans. CAF is available online in your Student login for providing fresh options for SPOT selection.

**3. I have appeared CPET-2021, but not entered the choice of preferences within the stipulated timeline. Am I eligible to fill choices in this SPOT Admission?**

Ans. Yes. You can provide maximum three (3) new fresh choices for the SPOT Admission.

**4. Can I change my subjects, in which I have not appeared entrance examination?**

Ans. No, you can't. You can opt only for the subjects opted in the CAF to appear CPET-2021. Eligibility criteria available in SAMS website will be followed strictly.

**5. How can I know that, how much seats are lying vacant in which Universities or Colleges?**

Ans. You are advised to go through the University/College wise vacant seat and cut-off mark details at SAMS website before making any selection of options (University/Colleges + PG Admission Subject) for admission.

**6. How many Universities/Colleges we can opt for in this SPOT Admission?**

Ans. You can provide fresh option (s) for the Institutions, where you want to take admission in order of preference with limit to 03 options only. **Options entered earlier in the CAF will not be considered for SPOT selection process.**

**7. I was not able to enter my graduation mark due to various reasons. Can I enter the same for this SPOT Admission?**

Ans. Yes. You can.

**8. I have already paid the fees and taken admission during 1<sup>st</sup> phase of PG Admission (1<sup>st</sup> Selection &/ 2<sup>nd</sup> Selection). Should I have to pay again if I will get a seat in another college/university in SPOT Admission?**

Ans. No, you have to pay only the differential amount.

**9. Whether the State -wide merit list published earlier has any relationship with the SPOT selection merit list, published by the institution?**

Ans. Not at all.

**10. I want to apply in 03 different equivalent subjects in one university. Shall I submit 03 sets of CAF and other documents in 03 different Departments?**

Ans. Yes, you will have to submit 03 sets of documents physically in 03 different departments. You can't send them by post. Because that may not reach the destination within the stipulated timeline. Refer Point No. 5 (N.B.) of the Guidelines published by the Higher Education Department on 12/11/21.

**11. I want to apply in 03 different institutions. Shall I submit 03 sets of CAF and other documents in 03 different Institutions?**

Ans. Yes, you will have to submit 03 sets of documents physically in 03 different Institutions. You can't send them by post. Because that may not reach the destination within the stipulated timeline. Refer Point No. 5 (N.B.) of the Guidelines published by the Higher Education Department on 12/11/21.

**12. I have taken admission in my first selection college/university and now I have decided not to study the PG Course anymore. Shall I get back my admission Fees?**

Ans. Yes, your admission fees will be returned to you after the completion of the entire admission process for the year 2021-22.

**13. Can I opt for Slide up in SPOT Admission?**

Ans. No. There will not be any slide up option for SPOT selection.

**14. If Intimation Letter is generated for SPOT Admission, can I be allowed to remain in the previous Institution?**

Ans. No. Once Intimation is generated, you are not allowed to remain in the previous option nor change to another option. Other options will be closed for you.

**15. Will the reservation and weightage be applicable for SPOT selection?**

Ans. Yes, it is applicable. But, if no such candidates are available, then Institutions can de-reserve those seats.

**16. How can I get Transfer Certificate to take admission in SPOT selection?**

Ans. TC will be automatically generated after successful payment of Admission fees. You need not go to the previous institution to receive TC.

**17. What documents I need to submit at the institution to take admission?**

Ans. You have to submit photocopy of CAF along with mark sheets (Matriculation to Degree), certificates claiming reservation & weightage (if any).
