

If a Reserve Category candidate (i.e. SC,ST, PwD & ESM/SDP/CoM) after reporting under General Category in P.G SPOT admission (because of his/her marks within the cut-off mark for General Category) does not get a seat under General Category after selection, then s/he can be treated against the vacancies of her/his respective category and selection will be done accordingly.

**FOR EXAMPLE:**

**‘XX’ University: ‘Y’ Deptt.**

<i>Category</i>	<i>General</i>	<i>SC</i>	<i>ST</i>
<i>Vacant Seats</i>	<i>5</i>	<i>3</i>	<i>2</i>
<i>Cut-off for SPOT</i>	<i>80%</i>	<i>63%</i>	<i>65%</i>

One SC candidate has secured 81%, therefore s/he was placed under General Category, but after reporting, when institution selected candidates against 5 vacancies, s/he did not get a seat, because cut-off marks after selection is 85%.

*In such scenario*, that SC candidate securing 81% will be selected against SC category and if her/his mark comes within the cut-off mark of selected candidates of that particular category, then s/he will be selected.

<i>Similarly this principle should cover other reservation categories</i>
